## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Newport-Mesa Federation of Teachers

Newport-Mesa Unified School District

Implementation Senate Bill 328 (SB 328)

The Newport-Mesa Federation of Teachers (NMFT) and Newport-Mesa Unified School District (NMUSD) recognize SB 328 requires the school day for middle school students to begin no earlier than 8:00 A.M. and for high schools no earlier than 8:30 A.M. by July 1, 2022. SB 328 does not prohibit NMUSD from offering classes or activities to groups of students during a zero period, before the start of the school day.

The Parties agree, Back Bay/Monte Vista High School, Costa Mesa Middle/High School, Corona del Mar Middle/High School, Estancia High School, and Newport Harbor High School, Cloud Campus (High School only) will begin first period/period one at 8:30 A.M for the 2022-2023 school year. In order to coordinate transportation and limit changes to other schools, first period at TeWinkle Middle School will commence at 8:00 A.M. and at Ensign Intermediate School at 8:15 A.M.

For the 2022-2023 school year, the scheduling of the instructional day may be reconfigured in accordance with the Collective Bargaining Agreement, Section 3.2.3.1 and Appendix D. Parties understand that in future years start times must comply with the provisions of SB 328.

This MOU does not set precedent or effect any provision of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between NMFT and NMUSD.
